I would like to thank PC Jim Benjamin for inviting me to present the wreath for the CYC during the service at Long Wharf on Memorial Day. It was my honor and privilege to do so. For those that did not attend let me tell you the story that was told that day. As an Army veteran I had heard the story but did not know about the name of the ship. The (Sailing Ship) SS Dorchester was built in 1926 to run passengers and material from Boston to Miami. It was refitted for service during World War II in Feb. of 1942 when it was commissioned the (United States Army Transport) USAT Dorchester. On a fateful night 1 year later on Feb. 3rd 1943 55 min after midnight a German (U–Boat) U–233 torpedoed and sank the Dorchester hitting her in the boiler room which made her sink to the bottom of the cold Atlantic in 20 minutes. In those 20 minutes four Army Chaplains helped with life vest and get people into life rafts and prayed. But these 4 Army Chaplains did more than just that, when they ran out of life vests they took off their own and handed them to 4 soldiers so they could have a chance to live. And as the USAT Dorchester goes down the 4 Chaplains cross arms and began to pray and sing hymns until their final prayers are answered.

And that, my friend, is why we celebrate Memorial Day.

But it also got me thinking of doing something else to remember and thank people for what they did. PC Benjamin was in his airborne uniform complete with his corporal stripes and jump boots and they all still fit. I can't even get my Army Dress Green jacket on. I haven't asked him yet but I want to get his story and let our members know the kind of people they walk by when they come to the club. And I will do a little story on 6 different members for the next 6 months.
